



This form must be completed and returned to the Office of Financial Aid by first-time freshmen and transfer students applying to CIA, who applied to CIA but chose not to provide their social security number.

Post-secondary schools like CIA must receive your social security number (SSN) or, if you are not eligible to obtain an SSN, your taxpayer identification number (ITIN). These identification numbers are required in order to receive any aid from CIA, including merit-based scholarships and other types of financial aid.

The SSN or ITIN are used to submit information to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). The SSN or ITIN are also used to furnish you with a form (Form 1098T, Tuition Statement) that you will need when completing your federal IRS Tax Return each year you are in college.
